

## SATE – School Adoption in Teacher Education

SATE is a 3-year project which started in September 2016. Lyshøjskolen is a partner in the project with UCSyd and universities in Germany, Norway and Russia

SATE is a transnational project that aims to bridge the existing gap between schools and teacher education by connecting national experience, knowledge and knowhow within European Teacher Education and work out a guideline for School adoption at its best.

School adoption is a win-win situation. By taking over a school for a whole week the teacher students get an authentic image of what it takes to be a teacher and while testing their academic knowledge, they are continuously supported by a mentor. The school teachers can participate in professional development classes during the week to strengthen their skills and competences.
